## Young people run away for many reasons

When someone is missing or has run away, it's a sign that something is going wrong for them. Runaway Helpline gives young people a safe space to talk about how they feel and help them to be safe.



Being able to talk to someone, share secrets and worries anonymously and get non-judgemental advice is key. Run by national charity Missing People, our team of trained professionals has been providing confidential listening support and advice to those who are running away and not happy at home for many years.

We help young people to make safe and informed decisions. We work closely with the police and social services but as we tell young people, "we're not the police, we're not social services. Unless you tell us your name or where you are, we can't find out.

We're here for one reason only: to listen to you and offer you support. You're in control. It's your call".

**Support for professionals:** We offer confidential advice to social workers, teachers, carers, police or probation officers, youth workers, or youth charities.

## We are here to listen and advise you if:

- someone runs away or goes missing from your care
- you are worried about a young person and would like some advice
- you are concerned about a problem in your local area that may be causing young people to go missing
- you feel that the young people you are working with are unaware of the risks of running away

## How you can help young people who run away:

- display our posters and cards in places where young people can see them
- list Runaway Helpline in directories or sources of guidance and support for young people
- raise awareness with young people about the risks of running away and what to do if they need help
- pick a theme from www.runawayhelpline.org.uk and host a discussion with young people
