Visit to Escape Rooms - Whitechapel - Year 11

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Escape Rooms, Whitechapel on Thursday, 16th January 2025. The aim of this visit is to reward the students in Year 11 who have shown gold star behaviour, with less than 15 negative behaviour points recorded during the autumn term.

Students will leave the school at 8.30am on Thursday, 16th January 2025 and travel by train to and from the Escape Rooms, Whitechapel, returning to school at 2pm. Students will be required to wear comfortable and warm clothing and have a valid Travel Card with sufficient funds for the return journey. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £32.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the nonrefundable cost of £32.00, before Friday 10th January 2025. Please note that by paying the nonrefundable cost, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip. We expect all students to attend this trip as it links to the broader curriculum. If payment presents a problem, please contact the finance team via email to <u>finance@uhs.org.uk</u>.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to <u>finance@uhs.org.uk</u>
