## Visit to Imperial War Museum - Year 9

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Imperial War Museum on Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024. Students in Year 9 will get the opportunity to visit the Imperial War Museum, where they experience what war was like for citizens at that time.

Students will leave the school at 8.15am on Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> July 2024 and travel by coach to and from the Imperial War Museum, returning to school at 3.45pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black shoes or black leather-like footwear. Students will require a note pad and pencil case for this trip, they will also require a packed lunch, including drinks and snacks.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

The cost of this trip is £25.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £25.00, before Friday  $28^{th}$  June 2024. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to <a href="mailto:finance@uhs.org.uk">finance@uhs.org.uk</a>.
